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Color Tour #1

A 73-mile tour that passes through the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest. Most of the route is paved; 12 miles are on gravel roads.

- Beginning at the Hayward Information Center
- Head North on Hwy 63 (5 miles)
 - Right on Hwy 77 (8 miles)
 - Right on Twin Lake Rd (6.5 miles)
 - Cross over the Tiger Cat Flowage
 - Turn Left on Hwy A (2 miles)
 - Right on Hwy 77 (9.8 miles)
 - Intersection of Hwy A and Hwy 77 is known as Dow's Corner
 - Right on Hwy S (4.1 miles)
 - Left on Moose Lake Rd (5.9 miles)
 - After 5 miles road turns to gravel
 - Right on FR 174 (5 miles)
 - Gravel
 - Right on Black Lake Rd (1.2 miles)
 - Gravel
 - Black Lake Rd intersects with Barker Lake Rd. Turn Right on Barker Lake Rd (4.8 miles)
 - You will pass over the East fork of the Chippewa River
 - Right on Hwy B (15.4 miles)
 - Right on McClaine Rd (3.8 miles)
 - Left on Twin Lake Rd (1.8 miles)
 - Left on 77 back to Hayward. (8 miles).

Color Tour #4

A 45-mile tour begins in Winter and passes through the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest. Most of the route is paved; 10.4 miles are gravel roads.

- Tour begins in Winter at intersections of Hwy 70 and Hwy W
- Head West on Hwy 70 (5 miles)
 - Right on Hwy. G; in the town of Ojibwa. Continue 7.8 miles on G
 - Left on Hwy W (3.5 miles)
 - Right on Hwy B (3.8 miles)
 - Left on Universal Drive (.75 miles)
 - Left on Black Dan Rd (1 mile, gravel after 0.3 miles)
 - Left on Clover Rd (3.4 miles)
 - Right on Blaisdell Lake Rd (4.7 miles)
 - Left on GG (.5 miles)
 - Right on FR 311 (Bear Lake Rd.) (5.4 miles, gravel)
 - Half-mile past Dead Horse Run ATV trail, turn right on FR 162 (5.2 miles, gravel)
 - Right on Hwy 70, follow back to Winter (14.5 miles)

Color Tour #3

A 70-mile tour that passes through the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest east of Hayward. Most of the tour is on paved roads; 8.5 miles are on gravel road.

- Beginning at the Hayward Information Center
- Head North on Hwy 63 (.5 miles)
 - Right on Hwy 77 (21.9 miles)
 - Blacktop for 2 miles then changes to gravel
 - Can turn left on to FR 622 for a short side trip to Lynch Creek, short hike to a viewing platform
 - Left on Hwy M to Cable (9.8 miles)
 - Can take a walking side trip by driving south on FR 207, hiking in to Rock Lake
 - In Cable turn left on Hwy 63 (12.4 miles)
 - No color tour sign at this intersection of Hwy M and Hwy 63
 - 5 Miles south of Seeley take a right on Nelson Lake Rd (3.8 miles)
 - Right on Hwy T (3.3 miles)
 - Left on Hwy 27 (3.6 miles)
 - Left on Hwy 77 to Hayward (3.8 miles)

Color Tour #2

A 60-mile loop giving the visitor spectacular views of the Chippewa Flowage and colorful forests

- Beginning at the Hayward Information Center
- Head Southwest on Hwy 63 to intersection of Hwy B and Hwy 27
 - At 0.5 miles take a left at the stoplight and continue East on Hwy B (13 miles)
 - Right on Hwy CC (14 miles)
 - You will cross a bridge and have a view of the Chippewa Flowage to both sides
 - Approximately 200 islands in the Chippewa Flowage.
 - Continue straight on Hwy N (4 miles)
 - Left on Hwy E (5.6 miles)
 - Right on Hwy 27 (4.8 miles)
 - Right on Hwy K (7.4 miles)
 - Left on Hwy E (3 miles)
 - Left on Williams Rd (4.2 miles)
 - Right on Hwy 27 to Hayward (4.4 miles)



Color Tour #5

A 45-mile long tour, all on paved roads.

Begin at intersection of Hwy 70 and Hwy H in Radisson

- North on Hwy H (8.3 miles)
- Left on Hwy CC (3.9 miles)
- Left to continue on Hwy CC (5.6 miles)
- Right on Hwy 70 (2.5 miles)
- Left on Hwy C (15 miles)
 - Hwy C crosses Hwy 48
 - Look out and see the Blue Hills to your right
- Right on Hwy 48 in Exeland (1.4 miles)
- Left on Hwy 40, Back to Radisson (7.8 miles)

Color Tour #6

The Stone Lake tour is 48 miles long and includes 14.8 miles of gravel roads.

Begin the tour in downtown Stone Lake at the intersection of Main St. and Hwy. 70

- Southwest on Hwy 70 (.3 miles)
- Left on Hwy BB (2.1 miles)
- Continue on to Ranch Rd. (2.9 miles). The road passes between Sissabagama Lake and Little Sissabagama Lake. It changes to gravel at 2.9 miles and becomes Little Sissabagama Rd. Continue 0.9 miles, then left at the Y intersection.
- Continue on Little Sissabagama Rd. for another 2.5 miles.
- Right on Co. Rd. F (5.6 miles)
- Left on Hwy. 48/F (0.3 miles)
- Right on F (1.4 miles)
- Left on Stoney Hill Rd. (7 miles; at 0.7 miles, turns to gravel)
- Left on Hwy. 48 (2.9 miles)
- Right on NE Shore Drive (5.3 miles)
- Left on Chapel Rd. (0.2 miles)
- Just before Co. Rd. F, take an angle right on Summit Lake Rd. (gravel) (2.8 miles)
- Right on Right of Way Rd. (2.4 miles)
- Left on Butler Rd. (1.1 miles). (There may not be a road sign for Butler Rd.)
- Left on Hwy. 27/70 (6.2 miles)
- Left on Hwy. 70 back to Stone Lake (2.5 miles)
